2019 NETLA FUTURITY FOR HEIFERS AND BULLS
June 22, 2019 7:00pm Frederick Fairgrounds, Frederick, MD

Open to Junior and Senior heifers (born January 2017 through December 2018) and bulls born January 2017 through December 2018.

First and second place class winners are eligible for the ITLA International All Star Futurity Finals to be held at the ITLA Championship Show.

Rules:

1. Cattle must be registered with the ITLA or TLBAA.
2. Cattle must be entered in at least one of the NETLA qualifying shows June 23 or June 24 (at the same location) in their respective age classes in either the haltered or non-haltered show.
3. Heifer classes will be divided into junior and senior divisions based on ITLA classifications. Within these divisions the heifers will be divided into groups (not to exceed 3) and these classes will be placed. The respective class winners will compete for an overall championship in each division.
4. Bull classes will be divided into groups (not to exceed 3.) These classes will be placed and the respective class winners will compete for an overall championship.
5. Bulls will be judged at halter. Heifers will be judged loose and grouped together for their classes.
6. Premiums will be paid through fourth place in each class. The top winning breeder/owner in each class will receive an additional premium. Each champion will receive an additional premium and a belt buckle (or similar prize.)
7. The judging panel will be made up of 3 individuals, of which at least 2 are ITLA approved judges. Judging will take place by ballot and the futurity committee will tally the results. Prior to judging one judge will be randomly selected as the tie-breaker in the event of a tie within the classes.
8. Entry fee is \$100 per animal. Entries must be postmarked by June 8, 2019. Late entries will be taken until 6:30pm June 22, 2019 at a fee of \$200 per animal.

2019 NETLA Qualifying Shows

June 22 & 23, 2019

- Separate loose, haltered, and youth shows on Saturday and Sunday. Shows begin at 9am with pee-wee, youth, haltered, & loose.
- Fairgrounds will be available after 1 on Friday, June 21. Cattle must be in place by 8am Saturday June 22 for Saturday's show or 8am Sunday June 23 if entered only on Sunday. Futurity cattle must be in place by 5pm Saturday evening if not entered in Saturday's show. Cattle are excused at the conclusion of each day's events.
- Entry fee - \$35 per class per day for active NETLA members. \$40 per class per day for all others. Registered cattle not registered with the ITLA must pay a one-time \$5 additional fee. Group classes are \$35/\$40 as designated above. Youth show entries are free.

PLEASE FILL OUT A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM IF YOU ARE ENTERING THE SAME ANIMAL IN BOTH THE YOUTH AND THE OPEN SHOWS. (This would really help me!)

- Bring your own bedding, feed, and hay – straw and shavings OK but no chips. You are responsible for cleaning out your pens after the show.
- Health requirements – All cattle must be identified by a federally recognized ear tag. The state of Maryland now requires RFID tags so please make sure all newly placed tags are RFID tags. Brands and tattoos are not acceptable forms of identification for a certificate of veterinary inspection. Maryland residents must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within the last 60 days. All other states must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection within the past 30 days. ALL exhibitors must also complete the LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS SELF-CERTIFICATION OF ANIMAL HEALTH and have it with your cattle at the show. This form is available at <http://mda.maryland.gov/animalhealth/pages/fairs-shows.aspx>
- Pregnancy palpation information must be listed on the veterinary health certificates. If this information is not on the health certificate it will not be included on the judge's cards.
- The name of the youth exhibitor must be listed on the youth show entry form. This exhibitor can be changed at the show if another eligible youth member wishes to show the entered animal.
- A copy of the registration paper must accompany each entry. Any animal entered without a registration number will forfeit any ITLA points awarded at these shows.
- Exhibitors are not required to be NETLA or ITLA members but membership is encouraged. Member-rate entry fees will be accepted if a NETLA membership application and dues are submitted with entry forms.
- As these shows are ITLA sanctioned shows, the rules and policies of the ITLA will be enforced.
